## Winnegamie Dog Club Class Liability Waiver

## Please read the following statements and initial each if true.

I understand that I or other Winnegamie Dog Club visitors may be asymptomatic, but could still spread the virus to others, others that might greatly suffer from symptoms or ultimately even death. $\qquad$

## Winnegamie Dog Club General Rules and Requirements

## Trainees:

Trainees are permitted to train only one dog during a training class. Each person is responsible for the conduct of the dog they are training. Only one trainee per dog is permitted on the class floor. Please wear comfortable, flat shoes for your safety.

## Junior Handlers:

Trainees must be a least 12 years of age. Trainees under the age of 16 must be accompanied by a parent or other responsible adult. Parents must sign the training application for any trainee under the age of 18 . The training committee reserves the right to ask an adult to take over if they feel that the experience is detrimental to the trainer or the dog, or is disruptive to the class.

## Children and Guests:

Young children must sit quietly in the viewing section. They must not disturb the class or dogs during the class. Visitors are welcome to watch the classes at any time at no charge. However, dogs not enrolled in the training courses are not permitted in or near the training area.

## Dog Behavior:

The instructor shall have the right to dismiss any dog that is aggressive and is not able to be adequately and safely handled by the trainee. Any dog that is repeatedly disruptive to the class will be dismissed. In such cases, a proportionate amount of the training fee will be refunded and private trainers will be recommended.

## Refunds and Check Policy:

A proportionate refund will be available if the dog being trained dies, the family moves out of the area, or if the dog is dismissed for behavioral issues. Vouchers for future classes may be issued if your dog goes in season or has a significant health issue that warrants it not being in class for an extended period of time. All refund requests must be in writing to the Winnegamie Dog Club Inc., Box 713, Appleton, WI 54912 - Attention Director of Training. Please allow up to four weeks for a response. A $\$ 50.00$ fee will be charged for insufficient fund checks issued to WDC.

## Class Cancellations:

Classes will be canceled due to inclement weather if Fox Valley Technical College is closed or will be closing early. You will not be notified personally. Classes canceled due to weather will be rescheduled for the week after the end of the session. If the instructor deems the weather conditions too bad for class in the evening, you will be personally called at least two hours prior to class.

## Use of the Facility:

While you are attending WDC classes, you may use the fenced in yards for 30 minutes before and after class. The yard in front is for puppies and small dogs. The yard in back is for dogs of any size. If other dogs are in the yard, be sure to ask before you bring your dog into the yard. Some dogs are not friendly to dogs they do not know. There is a 15 minute limit on yard use if people are waiting. No unattended dogs are allowed in the yard. Prong, slip, or martingale collars are not allowed when dogs are playing with other dogs for safety reasons. Long leads are not permitted on dogs in the yard if other dogs are present. Please do not potty your dog on the grass strip on the far side of the parking lot. Most important, be sure to clean up after your dog. Scoops and garbage cans are located throughout the yard.
