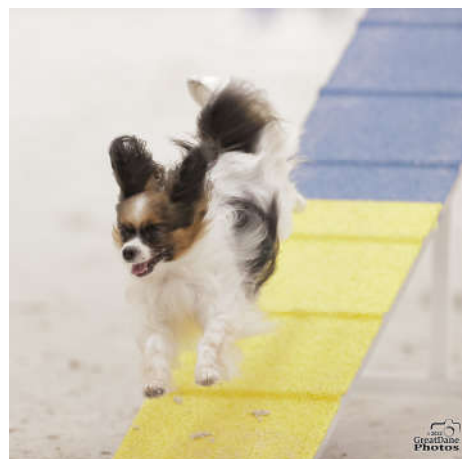
Congratulations Cruzr and Beanz!
