MEASURING and HEIGHT CARD INFORMATION

Effective January 1, 2010, exhibitors are no longer required to provide proof to Trial Secretaries that their dog has a valid jump height card as part of the check-in process. Furthermore, this change eliminates the need for a copy of the jump height card to be submitted with an entry form. Dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form may still compete; but they must be measured/wicketed by the Judge of Record PRIOR to running in their class and this measurement will be valid for that weekend of trials only. The exception to this requirement is a dog entered in the 24C' height division. However, if a Volunteer Measuring Official (VMO) or an Agility Field Rep is present; ALL dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form must be measured at some time during the trial or cluster of trials. This does not preclude having the dog wicketed by the Judge of Record if the VMO or Rep is not available to measure the dog before its first run of the trial or cluster of trials. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running and failure to do so will result in the cancellation of any qualifying scores.

Simplified Jump Height Card Process

When filling out the entry form, there is a section on the form for exhibitors to designate whether your dog needs to be officially measured. Please check the appropriate box so that the Trial Secretary knows whether to include your dog on the Dogs To Be Measured List. It is no longer required that you submit a copy of your dog's jump height card with your entry form or show it during day of show check-in.

TRIAL REGULATIONS - NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

POST DATED and RETURNED CHECKS do not constitute a valid entry fee. A charge of \$25.00 will be made for each returned check.

ENTRIES NOT ON OFFICIAL AKC ENTRY FORMS (5x7 Size only) OR PHOTOCOPIES OF ENTRY FORMS without the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the Official AKC Entry Form are NOT ACCEPTABLE.

A PRELIMINARY CONFIRMATION will be sent within one week of receipt of entry if an email address is provided. Providing an email address is highly recommended to expedite the confirmation process.

FAXSIMILE, TELEPHONE, ELECTRONIC MAIL AND UNSIGNED ENTRIES cannot be accepted.

MAKE ALL CHECKS & MONEY ORDERS payable to Winnegamie Dog Club. All fees are to be payable in U.S. Dollars.

ENTRIES RECEIVED WITHOUT FEES will not be accepted.

NO ENTRY SHALL BE MADE AND NO ENTRY SHALL BE ACCEPTED, WHICH SPECIFIES ANY CONDITIONS AS TO ITS ACCEPTANCE.

ENTRY FEES shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee. If the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee, entry fees will not be refunded.

ENTRY FEES for a dog that is injured after the closing date will be refunded (less AKC fees and judge's fee per day) if a veterinarian's certificate is presented to the Trial Secretary prior to the start of judging.

BITCHES IN SEASON shall not be eligible to participate. A veterinarian's note needs to accompany the request for a refund after the closing of the trial. Requests must be received prior to the date of trial. A \$12.00 service fee will be charged.

ERRORS ON ENTRY BLANKS are the owner's responsibility and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after trial has closed.

MOVEUPS

Not applicable for Novice Only Trials.

DECLINATIONS OF ENTRIES: The Winnegamie Dog Club may decline any entries for cause and may refuse to receive or may remove dogs on account of disease, viciousness or other causes and no one shall have any claim or recourse against the Winnegamie Dog Club.

JUDGES ARE NOT REQUIRED TO WAIT FOR DOGS. The Owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged.

DOGS MAY ARRIVE any time prior to Judging.

DOGS NOT REQUIRED for further judging will be excused.

DOGS PARTICIPATING must be fifteen months of age or older and must have an AKC registration number or have an AKC Indefinite Listing Privilege number. Dogs must be physically sound. Dogs that are blind shall not be eligible. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes.

AVMA HEALTH STATEMENT: Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal or external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

DOGS and CHILDREN AT THE TRIAL SITE must be in the control of their handler or parent. Any exhibitor whose dog or child engages in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the trial site.

Puppies under 6 months of age are prohibited from the trial site.

Pinch collars, citronella collars, electric and dummy electric collars, gentle leaders and similar halter collars are prohibited on the trial site.

THE SAFETY OF THE DOGS is a primary concern of Winnegamie Dog Club. By entering this trial exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

WINNEGAMIE DOG CLUB is not responsible for the loss of, injury to, or death of any dog exhibited, or the loss of or damage to any participant, whether the result of an accident or other cause.

MOVE-UPS

Not applicable for Novice Only Trials.

JUDGING TIME/COURSE FAMILIARIZATION

Briefing and walk-through will begin at 8:30 pm, with judging commencing at 9:00 am (first dog on line). Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, prior to the start of the class. No obstacle familiarization will be allowed. The walk-through is restricted to handlers entered only in that class. The walk through period will be held prior to each class.

EQUIPMENT SPECIFICATIONS

All contact obstacles will be coated with rubber skins in accordance with AKC regulations. Weave poles will be spaced 24" apart on center in accordance with AKC regulations. A breakaway tire will be used at this trial. A warm-up area consisting of a regulation agility jump shall be provided for all exhibitors. Exhibitors may not use the warm-up area to relieve their dogs. Obstacles will meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of the regulations for Agility Trials.

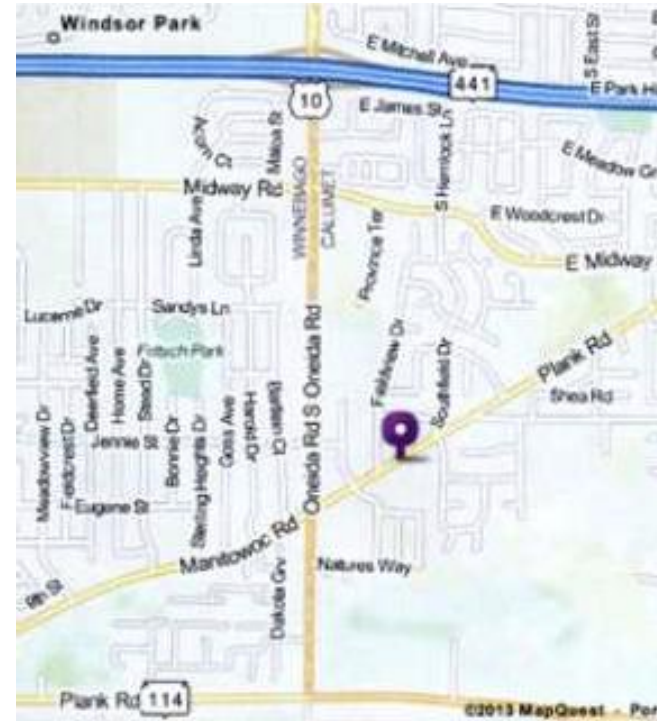
DIRECTIONS TO WINNEGAMIE DOG CLUB

FROM SOUTH: 1-43 North to West Hwy 10, go left. Follow Hwy 10 approx. 30 miles to Menasha. At stop lights (Oneida St), turn right. At the next set of stop lights (Manitowoc Rd), turn Right. The dog club is ½ mile down the road on the right.

FROM SOUTH (alternate route): Hwy 41 North to Exit 134 (Hwy 441 & 10), merge Right over large bridge. Exit Oneida St, turn Right. Go south to stop lights at Manitowoc Rd., turn Left. Dog club is ½ mile down the road on the right.

FROM WEST: Hwy 10 East. Exit Oneida St., turn Right. Go south to stop lights at Manitowoc Rd, turn Left. Dog club is ½ mile down the road on the right.

FROM NORTH OR EAST: Hwy 41 to Exit 145 (Hwy 441). Exit Oneida St, turn Left. Go south to stop lights at Manitowoc Rd, turn Left. Dog club is ½ mile down the road on the right.



FOR EXHIBITION ONLY (FEO)

For Exhibition Only may be offered at the option of the club. FEO is only allowed in Time 2 Beat and FAST classes. Participation in FEO is non-qualifying. FEO runs are treated as trial entries. The exhibitor must enter the class(es) (T2B and/or FAST) prior to the closing date, pay class entry fee(s) and the Trial Secretary must record the entry in the Trial Catalog as part of the results for that class. FEO does not need to be noted on the entry form; the handler will declare the day of the show. Dogs may be entered in any jump height for FEO runs. If entered in an ineligible jump height, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show jump height changes are not allowed. Dogs may be entered in any level of FAST. If dog is not eligible for the level entered, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show level changes are not allowed. The exhibitor must declare FEO in the ring prior to leading out. FEO may be declared earlier (ex. when checking in at the gate board). Toys are allowed in the ring. Toys must be non-audible. Toys may not leave the handler's hand. Toys that roll freely cannot be used. Food/treats are not allowed in the ring. FEO should be utilized for the benefit of the dog and not as a punitive correction. Harsh verbal or physical corrections shall not be tolerated. Any determination of harshness by the judge shall be immediately whistled and the handler will be dismissed from the ring. A judge must monitor the entire run. Judges can stop a run at any time

INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine PartnersSM program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner?

I CERTIFY that I am the actual owner of the dog, or that I am the duly authorized agent of the actual owner whose name I have entered above. Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other person. INSTRUCTIONS

Dogs may be entered in any jump height. There is no Regular or Preferred distinction at AKC's ACT events.

In order to acquire the ACT1 or ACT2 title certificate and have the title added to a dog's record, the dog must be registered/listed with the American Kennel Club. AKC Canine PartnersSM applications may be accepted at the event and submitted to AKC with the event's results.

Dogs that are not AKC registered/listed may be registered at a later date and receive their ACT title at that time.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine PartnersSM program should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler Number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner?
