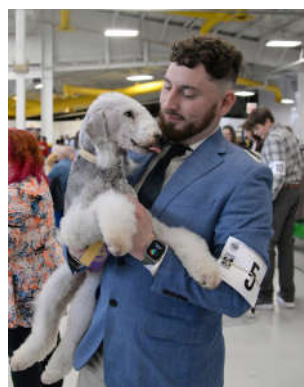
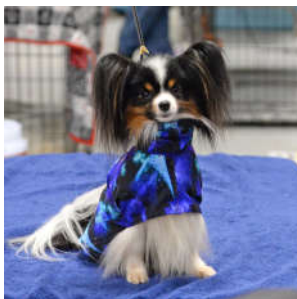

You thank her breeders, Tom and Mary Schulz for giving you the privilege to share the life of this beautiful and gentle soul.

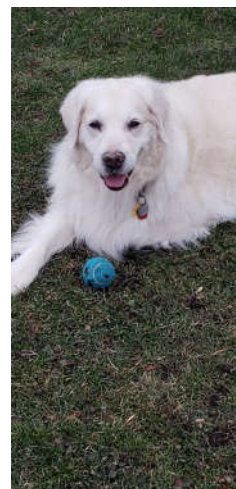

The WDC Appreciation & Awards Dinner will be held on **June 22nd** at the Winnegamie Dog Club facility in Menasha. At that time, we will recognize awards earned from **November 1, 2021 to December 31, 2022.**

New members - Awards are recognized beginning with the date of membership approval. Complete the attached application form, listing all titles and awards (one form per dog). If you already have a perpetual plaque, submit your application form, plaque, and copies of all AKC titles in the award box at the training center. Do not submit original titles. If this is your first plaque, then CONGRATULATIONS! You just need to submit your application form and a copy of the titles you earned and you will get your plaque at the dinner.

The WDC award box will be in the club office from Monday, January 31, 2023 until Friday April 7, 2023. Applications will be picked up for the last time on April 7. There will be no exceptions to these deadlines in order to get our club's order finished for the banquet. Plaques will not be distributed prior to the banquet. Only titles on the AKC certificates or AKC recognized organizations will appear on the plaque. Any changes the owner would like to make regarding punctuation, capitalization, or spelling of the dog's name should be clearly marked on the photocopy of the AKC certificate.

Special Trophies will be awarded for AKC Best in Show, AKC Best of Breed in a Specialty, AKC High in Trial, Best Junior Handler, Owner Handler, and qualifying for AKC National Championship or Westminster. Only one of these special trophies will be awarded per dog per year. Submit registered name of dog, owner(s), date and name of achievement and kennel club. Junior Showmanship: Name of junior- list shows and number of juniors defeated. List if the junior qualified for Westminster. Best Junior handler will be determined only by the number of other juniors defeated. One point will be awarded for each junior defeated. Certificates of Achievement will be awarded for any achievements the owner wishes to recognize at the discretion of the committee. (EX. RULES FOR YARD USAGE

- ♥ One of the benefits of club membership is the use of the yard to run your dogs. Therefore, you must be an APPROVED CLUB MEMBER to enjoy it.
- ♥ To identify you to other club members, you MUST have a yard pass hanging from your vehicle's rear-view mirror. This can be obtained from WDC's Yard Pass Chairperson after you are an approved member. If you walk or bicycle to the club, carry the yard pass with you. Club members who see a vehicle without a yard pass are instructed to call the Menasha Police Department.
- ♥ Picking up after your dog(s) is VERY IMPORTANT. As you're doing so, don't hesitate to pick up any that is missed by someone else. Most likely you like how clean the yard is, and it can only be kept that way through a joint effort from all of us.
- ♥ If someone else is using the yard when you arrive, be sure to ASK PERMISSION to bring your dog(s) in. Not every dog wants playmates.
- ♥ If you are using the yard and choose to let your dog(s) play without new playmates, please be aware there is a 15 MINUTE TIME LIMIT from the time the next person arrives. If no one is waiting, feel free to use the yard as long as you like.
- ♥ For the safety of the dogs and people, please do not use LONG LINES on dogs and refrain from using PRONG COLLARS when dogs are playing with each other.
- ♥ If the training center is rented out for a day or weekend, the yard will be closed, since BUILDING RENTAL also INCLUDES the exclusive use of the YARD. Dates will be posted before the event in the newsletter and/or on the bulletin board by the yard.
- ♥ Occasionally the yard is SATURATED WITH WATER, and dogs running and playing will tear up the lawn and could become hurt. During these times (usually in the spring), the yard will be closed. It will be posted on the bulletin board near the entrance and on the website.
- ♥ By adhering to these rules, we can all be assured that the yard will continue to be a place where we can enjoy some active time with our best friends.
- ♥ A 2023 Yard Pass is required to use the Club's front and back fenced yards.
- ♥ The new Yard Passes are **purple and white** and they are to be placed in the clear plastic hanging pockets. So, don't throw away the plastic hangers. Take out the old 2022 Yard Pass and place the new passes in the hanger.
- ♥ The plastic hangers are to hang from your rear-view mirror. If you bike or walk to the club, carry the hanging pocket pass with you.
- ♥ **Household** Memberships may have **two FREE passes**. **Individual** memberships may have **one FREE pass**. Extra passes are \$1.00 each and extra plastic hangers are \$2.00 each. If your pass is damaged or stolen, replacement passes can be obtained for \$3.00 fee (pass \$1.00 and hangers \$2.00). If you get a new license plate number, you will need to get a new pass. The passes will change yearly. **ALL CLUB MEMBERS MUST HAVE PASSES BY MAY 1.**

2023 WDC YARD PASSES ARE READY!!

♥ We need your help – please help enforce the yard-use policy! Look at the cars for the people using the fenced yards. If someone using the yard doesn't have a yard pass, please courteously ask him or her if they are WDC members. If they are not members, tell them the yards are for **MEMBERS ONLY** and tell them how they can become WDC members. If someone is abusing the posted rules, give the license plate number and complaint to any board member or Karla Smith.

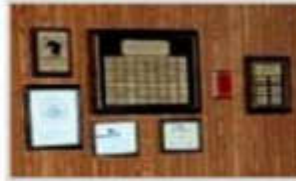
