Overnight express mail entries must have the acceptance signature waived. Entry form changes, additions, corrections and cancellations MUST be received in writing or via email prior to the closing of entries, be legible, and include the AKC number of dogs, or no refunds will be issued. No verbal changes accepted. Entries will not be accepted without fees. Canadian exhibitors must submit entries with checks drawn on U.S. accounts or with international money orders payable in U.S. funds. Post-dated checks and returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Secretary will add a collection fee of \$35.00 to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitor may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis. Each entry must be on an Official AKC Entry Form and must include the Agreement and Rules that are on the reverse side of the entry form. Entries must be signed by the owner or the owner's duly authorized agent, otherwise the entry cannot be accepted. Entries submitted without fees will not be accepted. No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance.

REFUNDS:

No entry fees will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed because of riots, civil disturbances, fire, act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a judge, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee. Bitches in season on the day of the trial are not permitted to compete. Entry fees for bitches in season or a dog that is injured after the closing date will be refunded (minus \$5.00 per day administration fee) if a veterinarian's certificate is presented to the Trial Secretary prior to the start of judging on February 17, 2023. No refunds for duplicate entries. We will make every effort to find all duplicate entries, but if an entry has been processed, no refund will be made.

CONFIRMATION OF ENTRIES

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

- These trials are open to all AKC registered breeds.
- An entry for a dog for more than one day MUST be identical. If a dog is to be entered in different classes each day, use a separate entry form for each day.
- Owners are responsible for completing entry forms correctly. Owners are responsible for errors on the entry forms and no entry fee will be refunded in the event of such errors or cancellations of entries after the published closing date.
- The Show Committee and Show Secretary will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, nor assume any liability in the event of an accident or misfortune to either dogs or exhibitors participating in these trials.
- All dogs present must be held on leash or confined to their crates, except when competing.
- Dogs are not required to be at the trial until the scheduled time of judging. All dogs not needed for further judging are excused. All dogs not needed for further judging are excused. The owner or handler of each dog is solely responsible for having the dog ready at ringside when the class is to be judged. Every effort will be made to accommodate conflicts, but no guarantees can be made if a handler/dog is not ready for their scheduled run. Please politely report any conflicts to the gate steward as soon as possible.
- Please turn off cell phones and/or pagers before entering rings.
- The building will be open for crate set-up Friday 7:00 am - to end of event,

and Saturday 7 am.

- No x-pens are allowed inside the building.
- The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendations to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations. Dogs should be able to perform all exercises safely.

Please help keep our show site clean by PICKING UP after your dog.

Anyone witnessed not picking up after their dog will be excused from the trial, with no entry fees refunded.

Please Note: the area on the far east side of the parking lot does NOT belong to WDC. Please use the exercise yards at front and back of the building to exercise your dogs.
