AGREEMENT

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. I (we) certify and represent that the dog entered is not a hazard to persons or other dogs. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog. Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other person. INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
- 2. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e, A or B division.
- 3. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
- 4. Dogs listed in the **AKC Canine PartnersSM Program** may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC Obedience trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC Number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box. Sire and Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.

Overnight express mail entries must have the acceptance signature waived. Entry form changes, additions, corrections and cancellations MUST be received in writing or via e-mail prior to the closing of entries, be legible, and include the AKC number of dog, or no refunds will be issued. No verbal changes accepted. Entries will not be accepted without fees. Canadian exhibitors must submit entries with checks drawn on U.S. accounts or with international money orders payable in U.S. funds. Post-dated checks and returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Secretary will add a collection fee of \$35.00 to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitor may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis. Each entry must be on an Official AKC Entry Form and must include the Agreement and Rules that are on the reverse side of the entry form. Entries must by signed by the owner or the owner's duly authorized agent, otherwise the entry cannot be accepted. Entries submitted without fees will not be accepted. No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance.

REFUNDS:

No entry fees will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a judge, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee. Bitches in season on the day of the trial are not permitted to compete. Entry fees for bitches in season or a dog that is injured after the closing date will be refunded (minus \$5.00 per day administration fee) if a veterinarian's certificate is presented to the Trial Secretary prior to the start of judging on February 14, 2025. No refunds for duplicate entries. We will make every effort to find all duplicate entries, but if an entry has been processed, no refund will be made.

CONFIRMATION OF ENTRIES

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

- These trials are open to all AKC registered breeds.
- An entry for a dog for more than one day MUST be identical. If a dog is to be entered in different classes each trial, use a separate entry form for each trial.
- Owners are responsible for completing entry forms correctly. Owners are responsible for errors on the entry forms and no entry fee will be refunded in the event of such errors or cancellations of entries after the published closing date.
- The Show Committee and Show Secretary will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, nor assume any liability in the event of an accident or misfortune to either dogs or exhibitors participating in these trials.
- Dogs must be on leash or confined to their crates, except when competing. When handlers are not present crates must be secured on all sides.
- Dogs are not required to be at the trial until the scheduled time of judging. All dogs not needed for further judging are excused. The owner or handler of each dog is solely responsible for having the dog ready at ringside when the class is to be judged. Please help your fellow competitors, the trial workers, and the judge by checking in with the table steward well ahead of time, and by being present with your dog when your turn comes to run. Every effort will be made to accommodate conflicts, but no guarantees can be made if a handler/dog is not ready for their scheduled run. Please politely report any conflicts to the gate steward as soon as possible.
- Please turn off cell phones and/or pagers before entering rings.
- The building will be open for crate set-up Friday morning after 10:00 a.m.
- Wire crates must have padding under them. No x-pens are allowed inside the building.
- The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendations to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations. Dogs should be able to perform all exercises safely.

Please help keep our show site clean by PICKING UP after your dog.
